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Your Bundle

Step 1: Get Ready

Let's get started!

Find a cool, shady spot to open your bundle. Take out your bag of worms, compost, inground bin, and mulch. These are all full of life, so handle them with care. We will save the worm castings for later.

Next, pick the place where you want to make your soil healthy again. This bundle is ideal for a 32 square feet. It can be in your garden or a raised bed. Choose a spot that gets some shade.

You don't need special tools. A small shovel or trowel is perfect.

Now dig a hole just a little bit bigger than the inground bin and place the bin into the Hole you just dug.

Step 2: Prepare The Bin

Sweet!! Now we'll make it cozy for your worms.

Start by filling the bottom of the bin with a little bit of the compost. You want it soft and fluffy, not packed tight. This gives the worms space to move and breathe.

Next, sprinkle a little water over the mix so it's damp, like a wrung-out sponge. This helps keep the worms happy when they move in. It's better to be too wet than too dry.

Your worm home is now ready for its new residents!

Step 3: Adding Worms

Now it's time to add your new garden helpers!

Gently open your bag of worms. Pour them into the bin on top of the wet compost. You don't have to spread them out, they will move and settle in on their own.

Don't forget to check the bag for worms that might be stuck on the inside of the bag.

Make sure to keep the worms out of direct sunlight.



That's it!

You've just an entire workforce into your soil.

Step 4: Feeding Worms

It's time to give your worms something to eat!

Start by adding food scraps like fruit peels, veggie bits, or coffee grounds and then covering that with a scoop of compost. The smaller the food is the faster it gets eaten.

Do's and Don'ts:

- Don't add meat, dairy, or oily foods.
- Do add compost every feeding.
- Don't leave food scraps exposed.
- Do add food when the bin sinks.
- Don't let it dry out.
- Do keep it moist

That's it!

Your worms now have a healthy meal to enjoy while they start building living soil.

Step 5: Keep It Covered

We are almost done!

Now that your worms and food are in place, it's time to tuck them in!

Cover the top of the bin with a 1-2 inch layer of mulch. This helps hold in water, keep the temperature nice, and stop smells from getting out. Think of it like putting a roof on their little house.

When the mulch the mulch starts to sink its time to give them another feeding.



That's it! Your worm home is complete.

Keep them moist and fed, so they will keep your plants healthy and soil rich.

Step 6: Water & Watch

Your worms now have a nice home so now let's get them all tucked in!

Check your bin every few days. If the mulch looks dry, its time to add a little of water. Worms breathe through their skin and need water for them to get oxygen.

When the worms are happy, you'll see the food disappear and find them all around the garden bed.

Now sit back, let them do all the aeration, amending, and composting so you can enjoy your garden.

Step 7: Maintain It

Every week, lift the mulch and add a few handfuls of food scraps and a scoop of compost to the bin. This keeps your worms fed and your soil full of life.

Over time, you'll see rich, dark compost forming inside the bin. That's worm castings or what we like to call "Black Gold!"

You can scoop some out when you are ready to make soil mixes, transplants, make a batch of extract, or just leave it in there.

Keep feeding, watering, and watching. The worms will do the rest!
